

Home Learning

Student/Parent Guidelines



Students must use the home code to interact with the class digitally. The 'Seesaw Class' app is downloadable from the Google Play or App Store.



Students will be provided with a home learning grid via Seesaw. Teachers will also connect via this platform with any daily announcements.



Keep contact time between **8.00am-3.00pm** with teachers. Please understand that while schools remain open, teachers are also occupied with students at school and will reply as soon as possible to any queries.



Students are encouraged to share their home learning via Seesaw with their class teacher for feedback.

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Teacher Expectations



Teachers will try to replicate teaching and learning in a home setting.



Teachers will create a daily announcement and lesson delivery via a grid format on Seesaw.



The home learning grid will include core Curriculum areas, such as Literacy and Numeracy as well as other key learning areas.



Teachers will offer acknowledgement on student work with a 'like' or comment.

- **At this phase:** School remains open. Attendance is above 40%.

Action:

- Staggered lunches for students.
- Designated play spaces.
- Drink fountains are only used to refill water bottles.
- Teachers prepare a home learning plan in the event of progression to ***Phase 3***.

- **At this phase:** School remains open, however attendance in classes is below 40%.

Action:

- Continuation of staggered lunches, designated play spaces, drink fountain usage for refills only (as described in Phase 1).
- Modified face-to-face contact time for all staff on site.
- Collapse the specialist subject timetable.
- Teachers begin a transition to home learning program via Seesaw.
- Students who do attend school will meet at the gate checkpoints, depending on their **year level** (see *next page for a map*). These students will be escorted to a classroom with the nominated teacher/s. Groups will remain small for the purpose of social distancing.

- **At this phase:** School closure occurs as a directive from the Department of Education.

Action:

- Home learning program begins via Seesaw.
