Hi Everyone

P&C QKR Account

I have met with Megan and Vanessa to explore the option of moving our P&C uniforms and events from Quickcliqs to QKR. We would like to see a larger portion of families pay electronically (reducing our cash handling) and as parents are used to QKR for school excursions/fees, we hope a move to QKR would help us. (For example, last year's Boost Juice orders only 64 families ordered through Quickcliq, out of 645 total orders.).

Vanessa is waiting for confirmation from QKR however it appears we may be able to be set up as a subsidiary to the school account. Our only problem is we need to have a Comm Bank Business Transaction Account to settle our sales into.

I would appreciate the Committee's thoughts on whether they feel a change from Quickcliqs to QKR would be beneficial.

Kindy Sports Carnival – 14th and 15th October 2020

Alison Forzatti has approached me with a request for the Kindy Sports Carnival this year. Currently our Kindy students do not have any involvement in our P&C Events such as the disco and colour run. We were thinking that the sports carnival could be a good opportunity to promote our P&C activities (these are the families that will be with the school for a long time!) and welcome the Kindy students to the school. We would like the Committee to consider allowing us to buy each Kindy student an icy pole for the end of the day. (From Woolworths, packs of 20 = \$3ea, total 200 students = \$30). I thought I'd approach Woolworths Harrisdale for a donation.
